- NO SCHEDULE CHANGES WILL BE MADE AFTER THE FIRST TEN DAYS OF SCHOOL (WITH THE EXCEPTION OF DROPPING AN HONORS CLASS).
- THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT VALID REASONS FOR A SCHEDULE CHANGE: STUDENT WANTS A DIFFERENT TEACHER, CHANGED MIND ABOUT THE COURSES HE/SHE WANTS TO TAKE, WANTS TO BE IN CLASS WITH FRIENDS, THINKS A CLASS REQUIRES TOO MUCH WORK, ETC.
